Technical documentation for development of solar photovoltaic plant on campus of university of Osijek will be used for both development project for actual construction with interested investors or it can be used for applying the construction of this project for EU funding.

Sustainable Energy Use in CBC Area of Croatia and Hungary

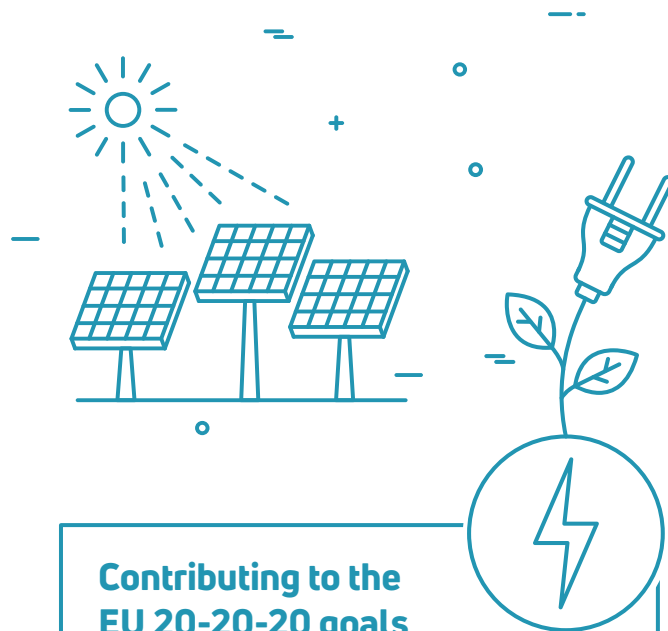

PROJECT GOAL

Sustainable usage of energy in the cross-border region

The primary goal of this project is to enhance CBC cooperation in sustainable energy by promoting appropriate CBC connections and share knowledge in order to foster sustainable and value-added exploitation of region's natural resources.



Contributing to the EU 20-20-20 goals

20% increase in energy efficiency, 20% reduction of CO2 emissions, and 20% renewables by 2020.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

- + Development of strategic and technical documents needed in cross-border area and local levels in order to implement various activities that will promote sustainable use of energy.
- + Conference and workshops: educational and dissemination activities with the goal of fostering sustainable use of energy in the entire CBC region.
- + Sustainable energy days: dissemination and public awareness activities that will promote sustainable use of energy to experts, local governments, academic institutions but also to general public in entire CBC region.
- + Transfer of the best practices from the old EU member will enable project partners to learn about existing best practices in EU and implement it in CBC region.



TARGET GROUPS

Educational research institutions and NGOs involved in sustainable energy projects will have increased capacity to provide services in fostering sustainable energy projects;

Local governments will build capacity to implement projects in sustainable use of energy, which will lead to reduction in GHG emissions, financial savings from lowered energy consumption and increased quality of life for its residents;

Other interested stakeholders in sustainable use of energy projects (academic institutions, potential investors in RES and EE projects, industry) will benefit from ability to implement energy efficiency measures which can lead to lower energy consumption as well as financial savings and from the increased capacity since they will be able to offer them services and expertise that will foster development of RES projects.
